Artificial Intelligence (AI) Task Force

WHEREAS:

Our world is about to change in alarming ways with the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) but for the most part we are unprepared for the changes; and

WHEREAS:

Many positive changes will be welcomed but as we embrace them, we are totally unprepared when AI runs amuck; and

WHEREAS:

It is undetermined if stakeholders such as labor, educational institutions, religious organizations, and minority communities will actually have input to this system; and

WHEREAS:

We must ask whether stakeholders are sufficiently informed to represent the interests of their constituents or, how do they gain knowledge for meaningful input; and

WHEREAS:

African Americans are always the last hired and the first fired; and

WHEREAS:

African Americans represent 12% of the U.S. population, and their unemployment rate is understated at 18%; and

WHEREAS:

In professional and scientific jobs African Americans are historically underrepresented.

We are 7% of mathematicians. We are 5% of the engineers and scientists; and

WHEREAS:

Also, as a consequence, the low impact of African Americans on a scientific level worsens as plans are being made by the federal government and Elon Musk to repopulate humans to other parts of our solar system; and

WHEREAS:

Many organizations are now meeting behind closed doors trying to decide how to grapple with these gigantic universal issues in ways that reflect the best outcomes for their constituents; and

WHEREAS:

CBTU, as a priority, must address the reality of AI or suffer the consequences.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists, without hesitation, establish a Task Force for the purpose of:

- Familiarizing themselves with the overall economic issues of Artificial Intelligence (AI) with respect to:
 - o types of jobs to be gained or lost.
 - Types of future jobs.
 - Ethical and racial impact on employment and unemployment issues in minority communities.
 - Lessening the negative impact on CBTU and their constituencies.
 - Working with other likeminded groups to pursue course(s) of action (political included) representing the best interest of its members and constituencies; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED:

That beginning with the next scheduled meeting, the Task Force will provide progressive

reports to the CBTU Executive Council and CBTU members will be kept informed of their

findings.
