March 5, 2024 - The Eminence Area Fire Department fire station burned to the ground.


The fire department lost every piece of fire equipment in the building including their trucks. The Eminence Fire Chief, Jim Bay, has ties to Sullivan Fire District, serving over 25 years as an active firefighter and officer with Sullivan. Jim is still currently an honorary member of Sullivan. When the news reached Sullivan Fire, we urgently reached out to our honorary member Jim to see how we could help. With several Departments across the United States reaching out to help as firefighters do, Sullivan felt more obligated to help one of our own. Several fund raisers and donation sites have been set up to help the Eminence Area Fire Department as they are not a tax supported district.




March 5, 2024 – Water Shuttle Training – Station 5

Franklin County Major Construction 2024-2025



2024 Projects

- 1** Route HH from Route 30 to Route O – Resurfacing, guardrail, and signs. Construction began 2023 and is ongoing.
- 2** Route 100 from Washington Crossing to east of Fifth Street – Resurfacing, guardrail upgrades, and ADA upgrades. Construction begins early 2024.
- 3** Route AP from Route NN to west of Nike Elementary School – Resurfacing and sign replacements. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 4** Route Y over Cedar Fork Creek – Replace Bridge. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 5** Route YY from Route 185 to Route Y and Route E from Gasconade County Line to Route 100 – Pavement repairs, resurfacing, guardrail upgrades, and sign replacement. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 6** Route CC on branch of Big Creek – Replace box culvert. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 7** North Outer Road I-44 from Route 47 to Crawford County line and South Outer Road I-44 from Exit 225 to Exit 226
Signal upgrades, resurfacing, guardrail and ADA upgrades and sign replacements. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 8** Route N from Route O to Route 30 & Route O to end of Maintenance – Resurfacing, sign replacements and bridge rehab. Construction begins Spring 2024.
- 9** U.S. Route 50 from Gasconade County line to Route C, & Route BB to Independence Drive
Resurfacing and guardrail upgrades. Construction begins Summer 2024.

- 10** Route MM from Route T to Route 100– Resurfacing, guardrail upgrades, curve correction, replace box culverts and add shoulders. Construction begins Summer 2024. .

2025 Projects

- 1** Route 100 from 0.1 west east of Fifth Street to 0.2 miles west of Route OO and on Spur 100 over I-44– Pavement resurfacing and repairs, guardrail upgrades, signal upgrades, signage upgrades and bridge rehabs. Construction begins Spring 2025.
- 2** Route PP from Route 30 to end of Maintenance – Resurfacing, guardrail upgrades, culvert replacements and sign replacements. Construction begins Spring 2025.
- 3** Route KK from Route C to Route 185 and from Route 185 to Route 100– Resurfacing, pavement repairs, upgrade guardrail and sign replacements. Construction begins Spring 2025.
- 4** Route F from Route O to Liberty Field Road, Route O from Route AT to Route F and Route NN to Route O to Route 30 – Resurfacing, signing, guardrail, and bridge rehabs. Construction begins Spring 2025.
- 5** Route T from Route 100 to Route 100 in St. Louis County – Resurfacing, sign replacements, guardrail upgrades, and pavement repair. Construction begins Summer 2025.
- 6** Route 50 from 0.4 west of Route AT to I-44 – Interchange improvements and upgrade lighting, signage and guardrail. Construction starts Summer 2025.
