Drinking Water Grant

6/3/25 - SFPD Receives Grant from Anheuser-Busch

The Sullivan Fire Protection District was selected to receive a pallet of drinking water to hydrate emergency responders through the Emergency Drinking Water for Wildland Firefighters program. This program, led by Anheuser-Busch and the National Volunteer Fire Council, provides free water to emergency services each summer.


Ladder Truck - 8812
