There are several projects going on in our district. I want you all to be aware of what's going on in our district in case you would get a call at one of these businesses.

Wal-Mart 350 Park Ridge Road-Interior remodel on consumer side. 1 additional sprinkler on island. This project is well underway and almost complete.

Sullivan Bowling Alley 645 Missouri Ave- Interior remodel of the kitchen, bar, and entertainment area. This project is well under way and the south side of the building is gutted. New kitchen hood system being installed as well as a Knox Box.

Bank of Sullivan 48 Shelby St.- Construction complete on a new masonry block storage building. This building sets behind the main bank and will come in as a Shelby address. It has a monitored alarm and soon will have a Knox box. Building is for storage only as of now. The building has a monitored security alarm as well.

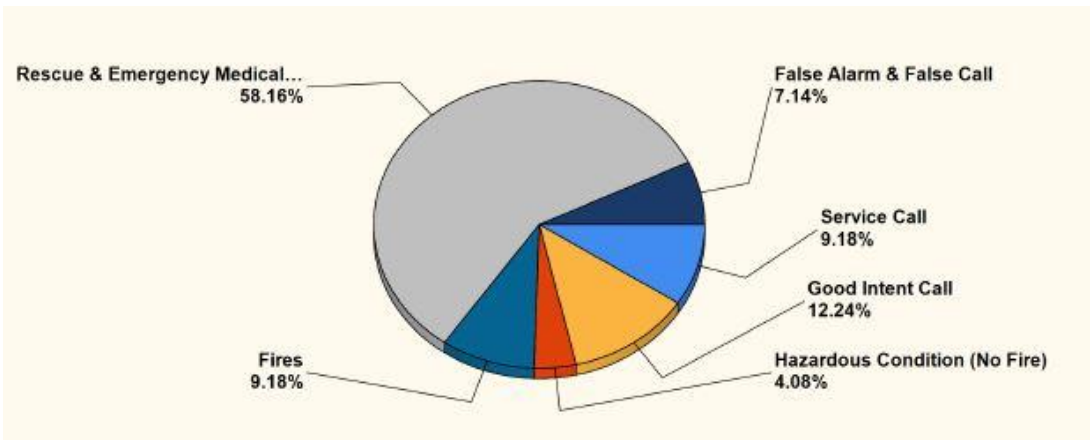
Wallis Oil 771 N Service Road. -Mobil has submitted plans and is in permit stages to remodel. New structure will be a Dirt Cheap with a drive through. No construction has started at this address yet.

I am strongly suggesting all commercial businesses to obtain a Knox Box to assist our entry after hours. Any new construction or any remodel should have one installed from here on out. It should always be located to the right of the front door, address side. There will be a red sticker on the front door indicating a Knox Box is present.

Last I want to thank the Board of Directors for taking our district to the next level in the Fire Prevention area. We are now going paperless with all of our permits and inspections. The board approved the purchase of a iPad for all inspections. Also all permits have been put on our website so contractors can download them at their convenience. This step is huge for our district and takes us ahead of most. Thanks again to the board.
