- The sprinkler room is on the delta side of the building.
- There is a pit under the pool area for the pump. Use caution when or if entering as this is a confined space.
- <u>DKI</u> final inspection was completed. Unsure when the opening will be.
- The Knox box is to the right of the door.
- The FDC is to the right of the front door.
- The sprinkler room is in the rear on the Charlie side.
- Main alarm panel is right outside the sprinkler room.
- There is an annunciator panel inside the front door to the right.
- This sprinkler system is a complete dry system.
