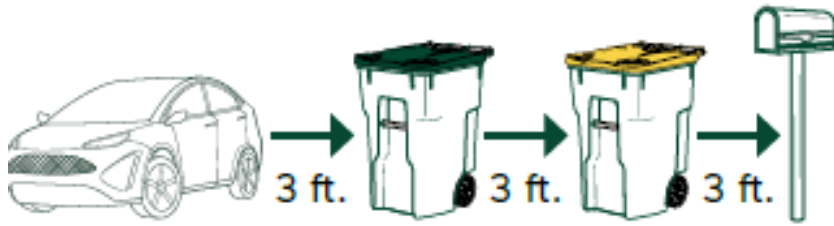

# New Trucks for Waste Management

In the coming months, Waste Management is switching to new automated trucks. These new trucks will use large arms to pick up our 96 gallon trash and recycling cans. Here are a few reminders to help with this transition.



**Trash will continue to be picked up every Thursday.**

**Recycling will continue to be picked up every other Wednesday.**

- All items must be in the can. Nothing placed next to the can will be picked up.
- Be sure to place your cans at least 3' from all other objects as noted in the diagram.
- Place wheels of cart towards your house as indicated on the lid of your cart.
