Vehicles speeding through our neighborhood has been an ongoing issue raised by members of our community. Because our neighborhood serves as emergency access between US 42 and Covered Bridge Road, we are prohibited from installing speed bumps or painting walking/bike lanes. To encourage motorists to slow down, your Countryside HOA board is considering a proposal to Oldham County requesting additional stop signs on Hayfield and Meadowland.
