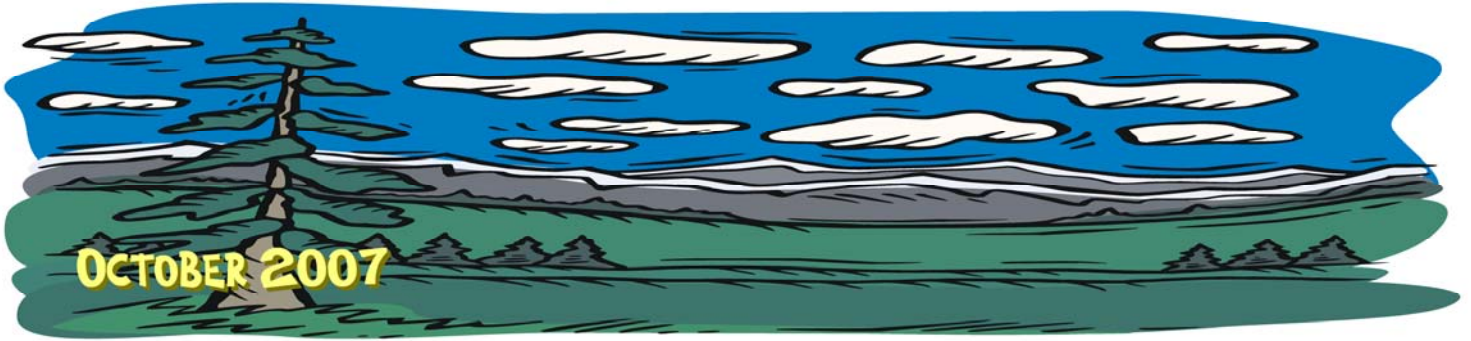


PINE NEEDLES QUILT GUILD DISPATCHER
