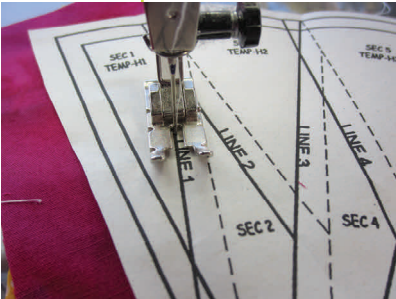

## Techniques and Projects to be Presented by Members

Presentations of techniques and projects by guild members Marlene Bowman, Lorrie Havens, Cristy Marxen and Beth Stanton will make up the program for the general meeting on March 12.

Marlene Bowman will demonstrate raw edge reverse applique on a small wall hanging. She encourages members who may be interested in starting their own project based on the demo to bring a piece of 18"x22"

solid black fabric and a white marking pencil.

Lorrie Havens will show how to make an easy pillowcase with hidden seaming. When used with theme fabrics they can make great gifts for kids or they can be coordinated with your quilts and used as gift bags and/or storage bags.

Cristy Marxen will be demonstrating the square in a square technique that will be a part of an upcoming step in the current mystery quilt.

Beth Stanton will offer tips on paper piecing. She hopes to help everyone turn out the beautiful precise piecing that the method is perfect for with a minimum of frustration. Her favorite tools to use include a glue stick, strip of cardboard, and Add-a-Quarter ruler. She plans to have a challenge block pattern available so that participants can practice the technique at home and have the block included in an auction quilt.

ries. Responding is completely voluntary. If you do not want to be included in the surveys, please contact Beth.

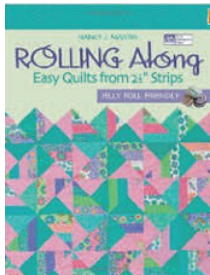
