We will be breaking up into teams to make these blocks. We will need sewers, cutters, and ironers!

Bring: Sewing Machine and sewing tools Neutral Thread Scissors and snips OR Small iron and ironing mat OR Cutting board, rotary cutter and rulers

#### MARCH MEETING SUPPLY LIST

#### **BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES**

- Sewing Machine
- Thread
- Scissors
- Pins
- Rotary cutter, board, and ruler

#### VICTORIAN STOCKING

- 1/2 yd muslin or similar fabric to form the base on which you will work
- 6 pieces of coordinating or contrasting fabrics. Raw silk and embroidered fabric from Bombay Silks works very well, but cotton or a combination of the two also look very good. This is for the front of the stocking. A ¼ yd of each should be sufficient. If there is a specific section of the fabric you want to use, you may wish to buy a larger piece. This fabric will be cut into strips varying from 1" to 3", so a small amount will go a long way
- 1 yd silk-like fabric for the lining and the backing. This should tone in with the fabrics you have selected for the front and could be one of fabrics for the front.
- 1 yd batting. A thicker batting is better as it will give more body to the stocking.
- An assortment of ribbons, buttons, beads or charms and embroidery thread (for decorative stitching) to embellish the stocking front
- <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> yd of cotton lace, approx. 3-1/2" wide
- 1/2 yd of matching velvet ribbon
- Large buckle for finishing

#### DIAMOND LOG CABIN CHRISTMAS TREE SKIRT

- Backing 1 1/2 yards fabric
- Foundation 1 1/2 yd. muslin
- Low loft batting 45"x60"
- Center diamond 1/8 yd
- A 1/4 yd
- B 1/4 yd
- C 1/4 yd
- D 1/3 yd
- E 3/4 yd
- F 3/8 yd
- G 1/2 yd
- H 1/2 yd
- Ruffling 1 1/2 yd (choose one of the fabrics used in the skirt and add this yardage to that amount or buy 6 1/2 yd gathered lace)
- Bias: 8 yd Cut 2" wide (choose one of the other fabrics and add 3/4 yd to the amount purchased.
- Thread to match backing
