In September, Carol Gaines and Lynn Crawford attended the Citrus Belt

Quilt Guild meeting to sell tickets for our opportunity quilt. The quilt was greeted with great enthusiasm and we made quite a few sales. One woman in particular, Renee Quail from Australia, thought it was the most beautiful quilt she had ever seen and bought \$20 worth of tickets. Imagine her surprise when Lynn emailed her in Australia to tell her she had won. She was thrilled.

Renee was back in the United States in January and met Lynn Crawford and Joy Agnew down at the McDonalds at the 15 and 138. She could not stop smiling and was so



excited. Renee is a doll maker, not a quilter. She was visiting her friend Barbara Miller who is also a doll maker, which is how they met many years ago. February Meeting

We will be working on Charity Quilts during the Tuesday night meeting. There are only 3 people signed up in each position. Please bring your supplies to work in one of the groups below.

- Sorters will go through the fabric in the cabinet to organize it for the event (probably better if it could be done right before the troops arrive)
- Fabric will go first to the pressers, to iron the wrinkles out.
- Then it will go to the <u>cutters</u> to be cut into 6.5" squares
- These will go to the sewing gals who will sew 6 across and 8 down
- This will go back to the pressers
- The pressers will give it to the <u>birthers</u>, who will pin the quilt sandwich together
- The sandwich will go back to the sewing gals to sew around the outside, leaving an opening
- This will go back to the birthers, who will turn the quilt right side out
- Then back to the sewing gals to sew the opening closed
- The sandwich will then go to the <u>Tie-ers</u>
