WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST, Saturday, March 12th

The workshop will be at the Methodist Church, 1543 Barbara St., Wrightwood, from 10am-4pm. We can get into the building anytime after 9am to set up. Please, have your machine set-up and be there ready to learn at 10am.

- Sewing Machine, foot peddle and power cord
- Darning foot, attached/installed on machine
- Light thread for needle and dark thread for the bobbin
- 3-4 bobbins ready to go with dark thread
- Size 90 Quilting Needles for your sewing machine
- Quilting Gloves, I use Machiners and find them very helpful
- 6 fat quarters size quilt sandwiches. Use fabrics that are solid or almost solid so that you can see your quilting
- Marking pen or pencil for the fabric
- Plain copy paper and pen or pencil for pattern drawing
