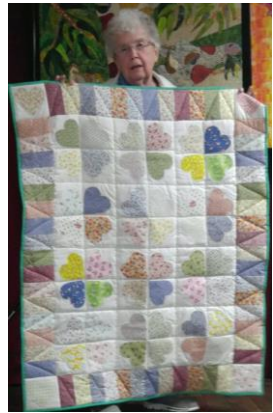

Traditional Hawaiian Applique Workshop

Supply List

1. 1 yard of Applique fabric
2. 1 yard background fabric
3. Chalk pencil or erasable fabric marker (that will show on background fabric)
4. Patchwork pins (straight pins)
5. Sharp medium size scissors & paper scissors
6. Water soluble glue (Roxanne's Glue Baste-it)
7. Sharp medium size scissors & paper scissors
8. Appliqué thread –to match your appliqué fabrics
9. Hand appliqué needles (long and thin are best)
10. Basic sewing supplies (scissors, thimble, needle threader)

** I will have fabric kits, fabric and all sewing notions available for sale during class.
