Her workshop on Wednesday, March 13 is the Icicle Burst quilt. We still have openings for the workshop. The name of her company is Orange Dot Quilts. Her lecture covers her unusual path from growing up in Communist Romania to having a successful quilting business in the country of her dreams. Her quilts are contemporary while incorporating traditional patterns.

Her workshop on Wednesday, April 15 is called Make it Modern. The class discusses what makes a quilt modern and how to modernize traditional patterns. She covers color choice, scale, composition, negative space, and quilting designs. The cost of the workshop is \$30 and you can apply your membership gift certificate to the workshop.
