

Just a little note since we don't have any fabric stores open near us, I have been watching Sew Yeah on line. They are a fabric store in Las Vegas. They have been selling fabric on Tuesday nights called New Stash, and Saturday nights is called Destash. Tuesdays is their new fabrics, I think the price is \$10 or \$11 a yard.

I generally attend the Destash on Saturday nights. Yards go for \$5.00, they'll have 3 one yard bundles for \$15, 108 x108 for \$25. They also have charm squares, jelly rolls and layer cakes, for good prices. You'll have to have a good computer connection to the internet. There are people from all over the world "bidding" for the fabric. Here's a link to the video that explains the whole procedure.
