## Sought-after Neighborhood by Tina Curran

Supply List (for quilt finishing at approx. 36 " x 36 ")
Fabric needs for the 16 houses

- 2 yards of background fabric (so 1 yard of a white background fabric and 1 yard of a black background fabric if checkerboarding your background like I did)
- 2 yards of colorful, patterned scraps for all the house parts
- Need about $1 / 8$ yard of scraps per house

Fabric needs for the rest of the quilt

- $1 / 4$ yard of fabric for the inch-wide inner border (to avoid extra seams in your inner border, the $1 / 4$ yard should be cut from the fabric bolt at approximately 9 " x 40 ", i.e., not a fat quarter)
- 68 pieces of different colorful, patterned fabric cut at $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to use in the outer border
- Just over a yard of fabric for the back of the quilt
- About a third of a yard of fabric with which to make binding for the quilt

Other supplies

- Neutral sewing thread for piecing (I use a 50 wt thread with variegated shades of grey)
- Quilting thread
- Just over a yard of batting
- Iron and ironing pad
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Any other supplies you usually use while sewing, including ideally:
- 45 mm rotary cutter
- 6 " $\times 12$ " and 6 " x 24 " rotary cutter rulers
- Rotary cutting mat
- Pins, etc.
