Old Saybrook Coastal Resilience Coalition, Inc. (OSCRC) is a non-profit organization incorporated in 2023 to coordinate a response to sea level rise. The Board consists of representatives from 11 beach communities in Old Saybrook, plus representation from the town.

The Challenge:

According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the global mean sea level in the Northeast US is expected to increase 1.3 feet by 2050, which will result in:

- Threat to property, roads, and infrastructure
- Sand erosion
- Tidal flooding
- Inadequate drainage
- Intensified storm surge
- Deterioration of sea walls, piers, and jetties


