Watercraft Storage Policy / Contract

Any SMA watercraft owners are welcome to store their watercraft at the clubhouse from October 1 through May 1. There is a \$300 charge and proof of membership is required as well as personal insurance. Saybrook Manor Association accepts no liability for damages while watercraft is stored at the clubhouse. There will be no maintenance of any kind performed on the watercraft while being stored on SMA clubhouse property.

The owner should print this agreement and deliver to Dave D'Anna (dmdanna3742@gmail.com, 860-335-4944) at <u>15 Hartford Ave</u> with a copy of their insurance and a check made out to Saybrook Manor Association.

The start date of October 1st is dependent upon the owner's discretion, however the fee is the same at \$300.

## Rules

- 1. Maximum Boat Length: 25'
- 2. One entry and one exit. i.e. once the watercraft is in, it can only be removed once, and the storage term is complete.
- 3. There is a 10 watercraft limit
- 4. No fuel can be in or on the watercraft
- 5. Boats must be Outboard Motor; no Inboards.
- 6. No commercial haulers. You must haul yourself.
- 7. An SMA Board member must be present at time of storage, and will show you where to store the watercraft.
- 8. Winterizing the watercraft must be done prior to bringing it to clubhouse. No winterizing at clubhouse.
- 9. Watercraft owner is responsible for any damages (including fence). Repairs must be made to the satisfaction of the SMA Board in a timely manner (within a month).
