## **SMA Board Meeting Minutes**

## March 26, 2023, 10:00 a.m.

Review of previous meeting's minutes. Minutes approved unanimously.

## **Old Business:**

- 1. Open clubhouse third weekend in May (see Item 8 in "New Business" for further discussion of this item). Dave D. will turn on water, etc. prior to then.
- 2. Some discussion of the new steps in front of the Clubhouse. Rosario will follow-up.

## **New Business:**

- 1. OSCRC (Old Saybrook Coastal Resilience Coalition) Dave P. did an update on OSCRC, which was officially established as a non-profit earlier this month. Ten beach associations are participating. Dave listed those, along with board members and officers, then gave a brief overview of the organization's goals.
- 2. Hammer Law This basically limits building of structures between May and September, except for emergency situations. We do not have such stipulations in our by-laws and would have to formally add them if we go that route. We will ask around to see what other associations are doing on this, then discuss further.
- 3. Air B & B We cannot tell owners what they can and cannot do with their property, but some renters are not following rules (see Item 5 below).
- 4. Security Cameras Should we install cameras at the clubhouse to deter vandalism? Board voted unanimously to go forward with this. Rosario will check with appropriate companies on this.
- 5. Renters Owners need to inform their renters of the rules and regulations. This will be included in the annual letter to owners. The board is not responsible for damages; individual owners are.
- 6. Wall Maintenance Jean called Pinder to follow-up and will continue to try to get someone to do much-needed wall repair.
- 7. Beach Update (Rosario):
  - a) Need to rebuild two ladders at the docks
  - b) Checking to see if we need more sand
  - c) Chalker Beach pulls sand up and away, making a bit of a barrier. We will explore this
  - d) Call Jeff regarding beach cleanup
  - e) Clean up by the new white wall on Hartford Avenue beach, and replant
  - f) Explore options for winter beach fencing (portable) during winter months, to mitigate beach erosion.
  - g) SMA Rules signs Discussed various styles etc. Signs will be ordered and installed.

- 8. Clubhouse (Dave D.):
  - a) Cleanup Day on May 20, with rain date of May 21. We will offer to sign off on volunteer hours for high school/college kids who volunteer to help.
  - b) We already have three bookings for the clubhouse, so need to coordinate our summer activities and block those dates (see Item 9 below).
- 9. Activities (Jen Cerrito): Three-page handout and poster board chart of potential activities. Group chose the following:
  - a) Meet and Greet June 25, by the Wall Beach, 3-5 p.m.
  - b) Bicycle Decorating July 3
  - c) Golf Cart decorating and parade, with hot dog roast July 4
  - d) Bingo July 8
  - e) Cornhole/Barbecue July 15. We would like to merge these two activities into a single event. Rosario will check with Patrick on availability for BBQ.
  - f) Bingo July 29
  - g) SMA 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday (two years late because of Covid) August 12
  - h) No Pasta Night this year
  - i) Miscellaneous Movie Night, Bagels on the Beach, Basketball Free Throw Contest, Morning Walk and Talk, Yoga on the Beach
- 10. SMA Swag Check with Keri on dates, logistics etc.
