☐ Allowing local pre-emption of state firearms laws. Pre-emption would allow Minneapolis, Saint Paul, and other governing bodies to pass laws to restrict gun ownership, conceal carry, and other firearms laws.

☐ Semi-automatic rifle, shotgun, and pistol ban including confiscation of arms owned by Minnesotans.

☐ Banning standard magazines for semi-automatic rifles, shotguns, and pistols. Call your legislators NOW to voice your opinion on these proposals.
