

Tromptown Marathon

Street Routes *Half and Full*

Half-Marathoner Route

- Start in front of school on Railroad street...continue to Fairgounrds and right onto Mechanic Street
- at end of Mechanic Street left on Rt. 13 (Utica St)
- after passing ice cream stand bear left onto Middle Lake roadcontinue to Lake and turn right onto South Lake road
- then a left on East Lake Road (on some maps called Reservoir Road).....then left onto the Dam road and soon a view of the Lake
- then left onto West Lake Road (some maps call this DeRuyter Road)
- continue to the intersection of South Lake and West Lake road.....at this point West Lake becomes Highbridge Road.
- continue straight ahead on Highbridge making a left onto Oil Mill road
- At the end of Oil Mill a left onto Rt. 13 (Cortland Street)....continuing straight ahead to the village main corners and then a left onto Utica Street
- then a left back on Mechanic Street to its end and the final left turn onto Railroad Street finishing at the front of the school.

Marathoner Route

- First twelve miles same as half-marathoner
- Except at 12.1 miles (the Pizza corner) one makes a right onto Cemetery Road. After the cemetery (located in the village) the road takes on the name of Lincklaen Road.
- Continue on this road for nearly five miles and then making a left onto Lincklaen Center Road
- two miles later there is an T intersection with Factory Gulf Road. Soon after that intersection Lincklaen Center road makes a right turn east and so should the runner.
- Not many yards after the turn one makes a left onto Dublin Road and proceeds a few yards to the turn around and then retraces steps back to the Lincklaen Center intersection, making a right turn
- you are now on Paradise Hill Road. From there one continues for nearly four miles taking in spectacular views before making a left onto South Hill Road, and soon after a right on Lincklaen Road, then a right at the Pizza Corner to the Main village corner.
- Then three more left's: onto Utica Street, at Mechanic Street, at the Fairgrounds onto Railroad Street and the finish at the front of the school.
