

UN-Private Sector Deep Dive Meeting on Health Initiatives in Cabo Delgado

30th August 2023, 09:00-10:30

Virtual on Microsoft Teams

Attendees:

Issues discussed:

- The UN Health Cluster provided a map of all intervention districts in the province, as well as partners and type of support offered per district with particular emphasis on the districts of Palma and Mocimboa da Praia. Approximately 85% of the health facilities in these two districts were found to be partially damaged. The data for the health facilities functionality is provided by the HeRams platform and data is collected by the SPS team and updated every quarter.

- From the private sector companies, Syrah Resources is working on the construction of a surgery block as a part of its Balama Health Program. The company is also implementing programs in relation to HIV/AIDS, Malaria, and vaccinations through health fair awareness programs. These efforts all being done in partnership with Serviço Distrital de Saúde Mulher e Acção Social (SDSMAS)
- TotalEnergies highlighted its role as the major private sector player in the health sector in Palma with: - Support to Pathfinder; - Malaria control and Infrastructure restoration.
- The UN Health Cluster identified the following priority interventions in Cabo Delgado province: Rehabilitation of damaged facilities; Provision of health equipment and supplies; Mobile health services; Reestablishment of vital services (electricity, water, etc.). Detailed needs assessments are also a priority, however, the health cluster does not have the resources to undertake these and is looking for support to do so.
- Furthermore, the following prerequisites are advised for these interventions to be successful: Engagement with the GoM, primarily the Ministry of Health/Provincial/District Health Services;
- The UN Health Cluster showed interest in understanding how the private sector can regularly update on its ongoing interventions and offered to include the companies' interventions in the health cluster's monthly bulletin.
