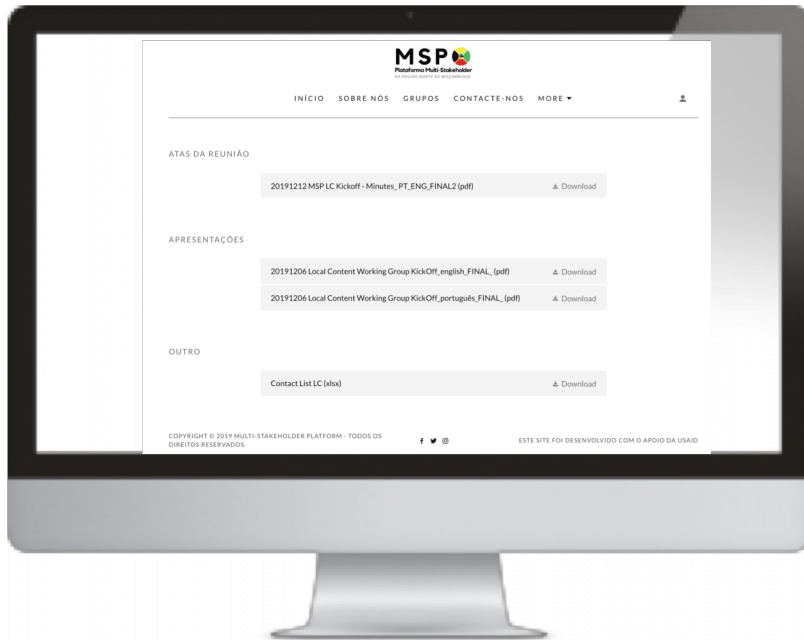


Digital map and database of relevant projects and programs in Northern Mozambique subdivided by development focus

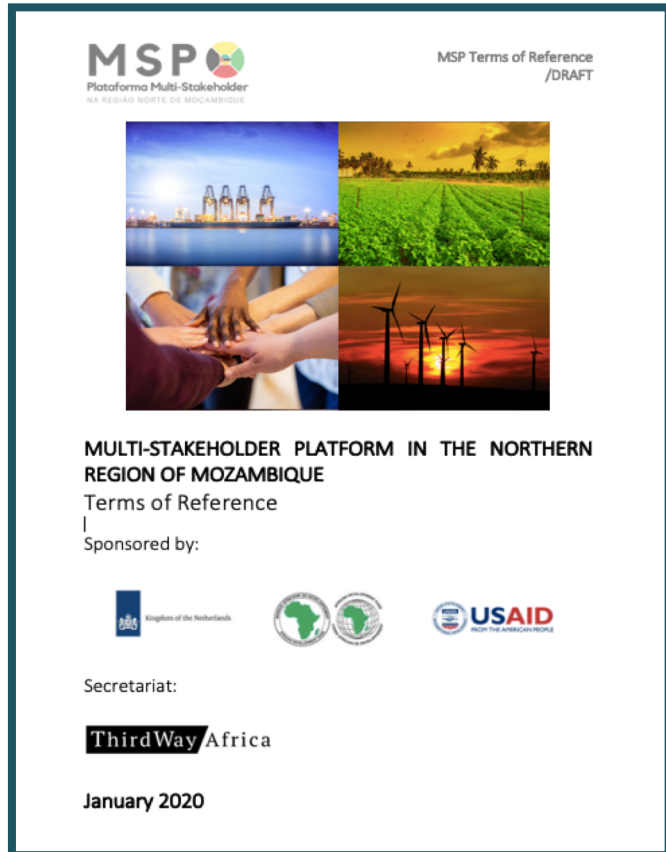

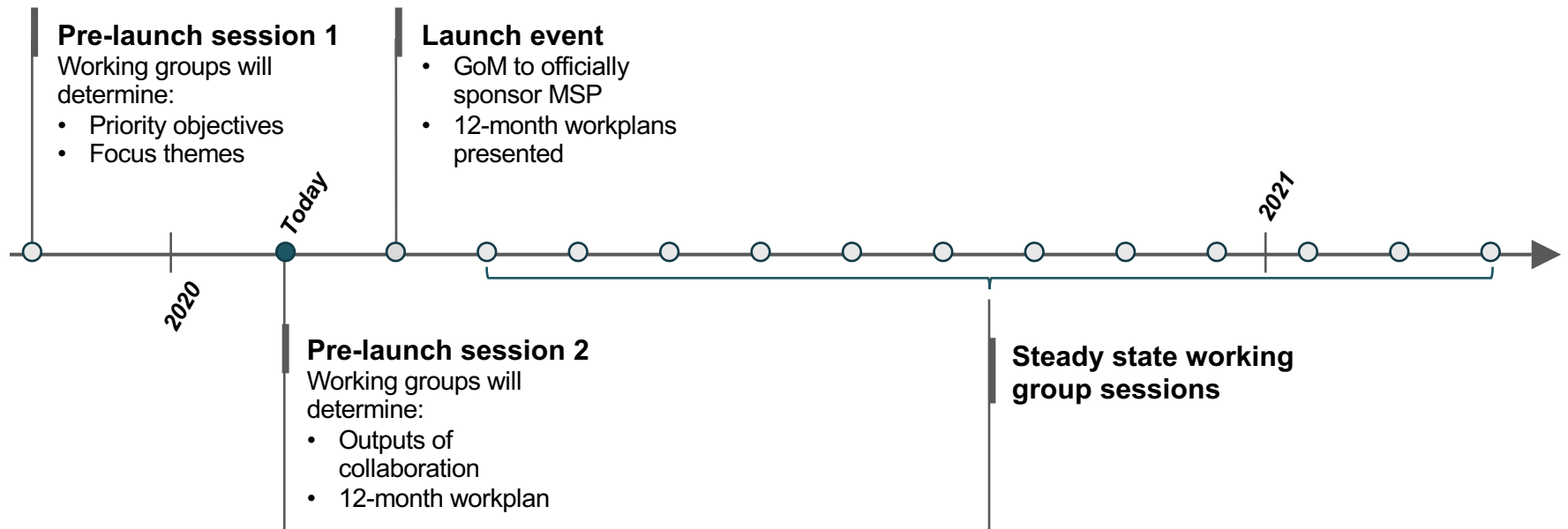

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Feedback from initial session: Priority themes for working group

Stakeholder surveys ranked the priority themes as:

- 1 Defining district/urban planning versus zoning
- 2 Synthesis of all urban and territorial plans
- 3 Uplifting and supporting local community livelihoods
- 4 Assessment and gap analysis of infrastructure in Palma and planning of critical infrastructure build-out
- 5 Anchor investment and private sector engagement to enhance Palma development plan

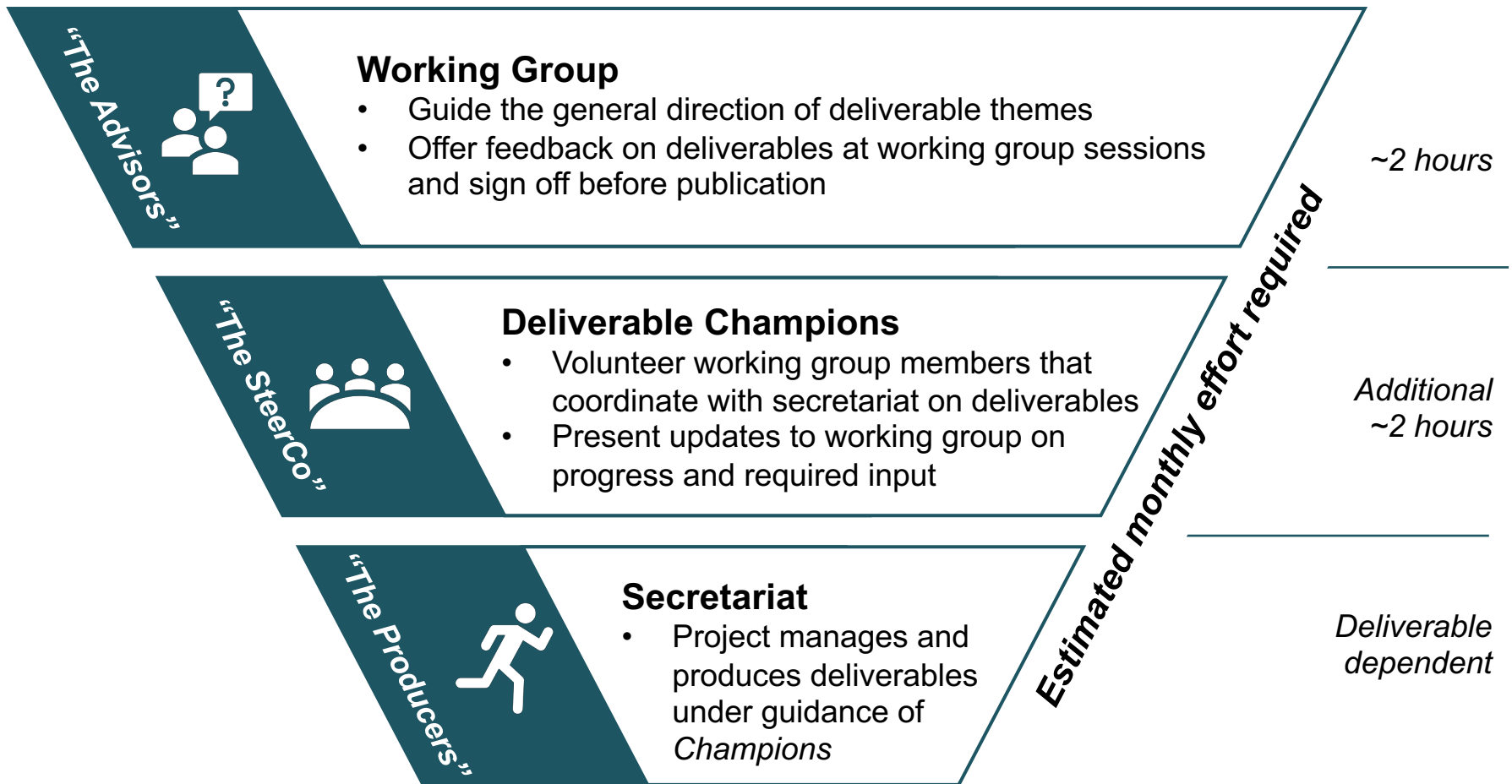

- **Database** – Repository of relevant documents, reports, and data sets
- **Info hub** – Online forum for sharing relevant articles and events

Key questions for breakout group to define

The deliverable

- What information would be most valuable to collect and share?
 - *Examples:* Consolidation of existing plans (urbanization, zoning, resettlement), thematic data sets (PIIM, dislocation, census and population studies)
- What of this information currently exists?
- What organizations could contribute to the database?
- How can the collected information be used?
- What policies should be put in place regarding privacy, sharing, etc.?

- Guiding the secretariat towards information sources
 - Liaising with other stakeholders on primary data requirements
