Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

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Mind/Attitude: Psalm 19:14

May these words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer

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Mind/Attitude: Philippians 2:1-2

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.

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Mind/Attitude: Proverbs 4:25-27

Let your eyes look straight ahead;
fix your gaze directly before you.
26 Give careful thought to the[al] paths for your feet
and be steadfast in all your ways.
27 Do not turn to the right or the left;
keep your foot from evil.

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Mind/Attitude: 1 Corinthians 2:4

And my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom [using clever rhetoric], but [they were delivered] in demonstration of the [Holy] Spirit [operating through me] and of [His] power [stirring the minds of the listeners and persuading them]

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Mind/Attitude: Colossians 3:1-2

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

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Mind/Attitude: 1 Corinthians 2:16

For who has known the mind and purposes of the Lord, so as to instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ [to be guided by His thoughts and purposes].

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Mind/Attitude: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-19

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit

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Mind/Attitude: Ephesians 6:18

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people

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Mind/Attitude: 1 Corinthians 2:15

Then what am I to do? I will pray with the spirit [by the Holy Spirit that is within me] and I will pray with the mind [using words I understand]; I will sing with the spirit [by the Holy Spirit that is within me] and I will sing with the mind [using words I understand].

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 3:1
My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart, for they will prolong your life many years and bring you peace and prosperity.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 17:22
A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 4:23-24
Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it. Keep your mouth free of perversity; keep corrupt talk far from your lips.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 2:2
So that your ear is attentive to [skillful and godly] wisdom. And apply your heart to understanding [seeking it conscientiously and striving for it eagerly]

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Heart/Attitude: Jeremiah 15:19 Therefore, thus says the Lord [to Jeremiah], "If you repent [and give up this mistaken attitude of despair and self-pity], then I will restore you [to a state of inner peace] So that you may stand before Me [as My obedient representative]; And if you separate the precious from the worthless [examining yourself and cleansing your heart from unwarranted doubt concerning My faithfulness]. You will become My spokesman. Let the people turn to you [and learn to value My values]— But you, you must not turn to them [with regard for their idolatry and wickedness].

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 3:2-4
Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 4:20-22
My Child, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to one's whole body.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 2:10
For [skillful and godly] wisdom will enter your heart And knowledge will be pleasant to your soul.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 10:8
The wise in heart [are willing to learn so they] will accept and obey commands [instruction]. But the babbling fool [who is arrogant and thinks himself wise] will come to ruin.

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Heart/Attitude: Proverbs 10:20
The tongue of the righteous is like precious silver [greatly valued]; The heart of the wicked is worth little.

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Sow & Reap: 2 Peter 1:4

By which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. Active Christianity states, "Everything in life goes exactly according to what is written in God's Word. There are no exceptions. This is a law of life that affects everyone, whether a believer or a non-believer. You will reap what you sow."¹¹

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Sow & Reap: 2 Corinthians 5:10

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

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Sow & Reap: Genesis 8:22

While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night, shall not cease.

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Sow & Reap: James 1:14-15

This death is reaping the wages of sin: a spiritual death where one's conscience becomes hardened and one cannot discern between good and evil. One lives in sin.

Active Christianity States, "All sin begins in the thought life. When a temptation comes up as a thought, if I agree with it, it gives birth to sin. To commit sin is to consciously do something that you know goes against God's will. This can be in word, deed, or even thought. ... : and when sin is full grown (practiced) it brings forth death."¹¹

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Sow & Reap: Galatians 5:16-17

So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

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Sow & Reap: Psalm 1:1-6

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.

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Sow & Reap: Proverbs 1:31

Therefore they shall eat the fruit of their way, and have their fill of their own devices.

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Sow & Reap: Matthew 7:16-18

You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit.

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Sow & Reap: John 3:21

But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God."

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Sow & Reap: Jeremiah 17:10

"I the Lord search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds."

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
