Basic care tips for your cabinets

- •Cure time: Please allow the paint 2-4 weeks to cure (we added a hardener to the paint called a catalyst. The catalyzed paint takes 2-4 weeks to harden which makes the paint more durable).
- •Wipe up spills, splatters and water spots as they occur.
- ·Clean spills as needed with a soft, lint-free cloth. **Use**Dawn soap and warm water for cleaning grease and spills. Dry surfaces immediately with a soft cloth.

 ·KEEP CABINETS DRY.
- •Avoid using tape, command strips or any adhesive on cabinets.
- •Avoid using a dirty dishcloth or sponges, which could contain grease or detergents.
- •Do not use products with bleach, ammonia or abrasive additives. Never use scouring pads, steel wool or powdered cleaners. Do not allow oven cleaners to come in contact with cabinets.
- ·Avoid placing small kitchen appliances (like coffee maker, toaster) where heat is directed onto cabinets. **Direct heat** may cause damage. For bathrooms, allow proper ventilation after hot showers and baths.
- ·Avoid draping damp clothes or dish towels over cabinet doors. Excessive moisture can cause permanent damage.
- •Please avoid bumping the cabinets with vacuum or mop, this may cause damage.
