### Fun facts From The Ground Up:

The grassy areas around our top parking lot have experienced a variety of interesting changes over the recent months. Take a peak and you will notice tall spindly pale blue/violet flowers called **Blue Wood Aster**. They are non-invasive plants,

native to North America which thrive in partial shade and provide important late season blooms for pollinators and butterflies.

Did you know...the flowers can be dried and brewed into tea and the leaves have a mild spinach-like flavor and can be eaten fresh or cooked.

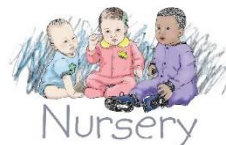
