The Gospel Proclaimed at the Brick Kilns

Early this year, Kingdom Heirs held a large outreach at a brick-kiln community north of Lahore. One hundred children received new clothing and gifts, and community members shared a meal celebrating the birth of Christ. After the Gospel was presented, the sick were invited to receive prayer. Several people later testified that they experienced healing in their bodies.

March: Ten Families Legally Set Free

Through the generosity of ministry partners, enough support was raised to satisfy the bonded debts of 10 families and secure their legal release from the brick kilns. They were no longer required to return to the labor that had held them captive.

Freedom needed a foundation. Safe homes were arranged, and 10 rickshaws were purchased so the families could begin income-producing businesses and provide for themselves with dignity. In June, three additional families were freed, safely relocated, and equipped with three more rickshaws.

April: The Community Witnessed Great Joy

Nearly 400 relatives, friends, neighbors, and community members gathered for a Freedom Celebration honoring the released families. Each family received a Kingdom Heirs Foundation Certificate of Freedom—a public reminder that the debt was satisfied and a new chapter had begun.

The Gospel was preached, and the community was taught what it means to be free in Christ. Many responded to the altar call by repenting of sin and placing their faith in Jesus Christ as Savior.

From a House Church to More Than 250 Worshipers

The Kingdom Heirs Church began as a house church meeting in different locations with approximately 60 people. It has now grown to more than 250 people gathering on Sunday mornings. Muslim neighbors regularly visit to learn what the church is about. Some have chosen to place their faith in Jesus as the Son of God. No one is pressured or forced; guests are welcomed with dignity and invited to listen, ask questions, worship, and respond freely.

Men and women have testified that they enjoy attending and have found peace since they began listening to the worship and the preaching of God's Word. We are reminded again: Jesus is the answer for every human heart.

June: A Permanent Ministry Home

At the beginning of June, a building was secured through a lease so the church could gather on Wednesdays and Sundays. The property was renovated with electrical wiring, lights, outlets, and a solar-power system. A water pump was also installed, bringing running water to the building.

July: Kingdom Heirs Christian Academy Opens

The Kingdom Heirs Christian Academy opened so children from the freed families could attend school—many for the first time in their lives. Nearly 70 students, ages 6 through 18, are now learning to read and write. Their studies also include basic English lessons and Bible curriculum.

These children once faced 12- to 14-hour workdays. Today, they are sitting in classrooms, opening books, learning Scripture, and discovering the possibilities Yahweh has placed before them.

The church is quickly outgrowing its present space. We are praying for land near the school where a larger tent structure can be established for worship, discipleship, and community ministry. We also hope to develop employment opportunities on the property, including a bakery or small textile business, so church members can work, provide for their families, and help others move toward freedom.
