Dear Friend and Ministry Partner,

We are asking you to prayerfully help Kingdom Heirs School provide foundational curriculum and school uniforms for children who are entering a classroom for the first time. Each week, between 50 and 70 students, ages 5 through 15, actively attend the school. Most do not yet know how to read or write, and many have had no previous formal education.

Before the school opened, these children spent their days working alongside their parents making bricks. The transition from long days of physical labor to sitting, listening, following instructions, and remaining engaged in classroom work is a major adjustment. Our teachers are learning how to meet the students where they are, keep them involved, and help them discover that learning can open an entirely new future.

The students are presently receiving instruction in their native Urdu language, basic English, Bible, and music. Our most urgent academic priority is to help every child learn to read, write, and understand foundational mathematics, beginning with addition and subtraction.

What the School Needs Now

Because the students have a wide range of ages but share many of the same foundational learning needs, we plan to begin with a common starting point and provide six progressive reading primers. As students master each level, they can move forward at a pace that reflects their growth.

- **Reading primers levels 1 through 6** — enough student copies for repeated classroom use
- **Writing and handwriting books** — materials that help students form letters, words, and sentences
- **Beginner mathematics books** — focused first on number recognition, addition, and subtraction
- **Teacher editions** — guidance and lesson support for every level being taught
- **School polo shirts** — the first step toward uniforms bearing the Kingdom Heirs School emblem

A book placed in a child's hands is more than a classroom supply. For a student whose life has been shaped by brick-kiln labor, it represents dignity, opportunity, and a different future. Your investment can help a child read the Word of God, communicate with confidence, and develop practical skills.

A School Partnership Opportunity

One school could make an extraordinary difference by adopting Kingdom Heirs School as a ministry partner. A Christian school, church school, homeschool cooperative, or classroom could pray for the students, help provide curriculum and uniforms, and exchange carefully supervised pen-pal letters. Kingdom Heirs Foundation and local school leadership would coordinate all correspondence to protect the children's privacy and safety.

From Freedom to an Established Ministry

Your partnership has already helped this work grow far beyond a single act of relief. The ministry is developing step by step, with each new stage building on the one before it. We want you to see the fruit your prayers and giving have helped produce—and the foundation that must now be strengthened for the future.

- **Families set free** — Thirteen families have been released from bonded brick-kiln labor, their debts satisfied, and their legal freedom secured.
- **New beginnings established** — Families received help with their transition to safe rental homes, and income-producing rickshaw businesses were launched so they could begin supporting themselves with dignity.
- **A church planted** — What began as a house church among the freed families has grown into a congregation of more than 250 worshippers receiving prayer, discipleship, and the teaching of God's Word.
- **A school opened** — Kingdom Heirs School now welcomes 50 to 70 children each week, giving many their first opportunity to learn in a classroom.
- **A lasting foundation ahead** — The next step is to complete the proper legal and organizational work for an established church and a registered Christian school.

A Family Bible for Every Home

We also desire to place a family Bible in every home we serve. A sponsored Bible gives parents and children a shared resource for family worship, reading practice, discipleship, and growing together in the truth of God's Word. Donors may give directly toward this simple but lasting investment in a family's spiritual life.

Building the Legal Foundation

As the ministry grows from freedom work into an established church and Christian school, we want to proceed carefully, transparently, and properly. We need to engage qualified Christian legal counsel in Pakistan to identify and complete the registrations, filings, organizational designations, and government requirements that apply to the church and school.

- Professional legal counsel from a qualified Pakistani Christian lawyer
- Preparation and filing of required church and school documentation
- Government filing, registration, and administrative fees
- Policies and records that support responsible, transparent ministry operations

Support for this work will help protect the ministry, demonstrate responsible stewardship, and create a sound foundation for serving families and educating children for years to come.

Land for a Growing Church and Community

The Kingdom Heirs Church is growing quickly and will soon outgrow its present meeting space. We are seeking partners to help purchase land near the school and establish a larger place for worship, prayer, discipleship, and community ministry.

A Multipurpose Structure That Serves Throughout the Week

Depending on funding, the first structure could be a large ministry tent or another practical church facility. During the week, the space could host job-skills training, educational workshops, and preparation for small income-producing businesses—strengthening both spiritual life and practical stability.

- Provide a stable location for weekly services, discipleship, and continued growth
- Offer job-skills and vocational training during the week
- Help church members develop and launch sustainable micro-businesses
- Build a long-term center for ministry, education, and community restoration
