Information for Pet Owners

Why Pets Stay Overnight:

- After surgery or medical treatment, pets may need monitoring.
- Some conditions require fluids, pain relief, or observation that cannot be managed at home.
- Overnight care ensures your pet's comfort and safety while they recover.

Our Overnight Care Approach:

- **Evening Handover:** Your pet's daytime vet provides detailed notes to the duty team.
- **Monitoring:** Pets are checked regularly according to their medical needs.
- **Medication & Fluids:** Administered as prescribed, including pain relief and supportive care.
- **Comfort:** Bedding, food, and water are provided unless restricted for medical reasons.

Staffing & Supervision:

- **On-site staff:** Our nurses and vets are present until late evening.
- **Overnight checks:** Patients are checked at set intervals during the night by the out of hours hospital.
- **On-call vet:** A veterinarian is available if urgent changes occur.
- **Referral option:** Pets needing continuous one-to-one monitoring will be transferred to a 24-hour hospital.

Communication With Owners:

- Vet4Pets hospital Northampton will update you if there are any significant changes overnight.
- You may call the practice during opening hours for updates.
- In emergencies, the on-call vet from Vets4pets Northampton will contact you immediately.



What Owners Should Know:

- Not all practices have staff on-site 24/7.
- If your pet requires intensive monitoring, we will discuss referral options.
- Please ensure we have up-to-date contact details for you.
- Bring any special food, medication, or comfort items your pet may need.
