

Installation instructions for Composite Fencing with concrete posts

Every fencing kit is supplied with 2 vertical composite U chanel inserts, 2 horizontal composite U chanel inserts and the required amount of boards.

2 x 1830mm horizontal inserts (one with 5 holes for the top)

2 x 1720mm vertical inserts

Screws for securing the top composite U chanel to the top fence board if required

- 1. Place the 1830mm length of composit U chanel insert on the ground or on top of the gravel board, making sure you are using the composite U chanel insert with no holes in it. (The 1830mm composite U chanel insert with 5 holes in is for the top)
- 2. Place the 1720mm composite U chanel insert into each of the slots on the concrete post you may require to cut these to suit the height of the fencing that you require
- 3. Slide in the required amount of composite fence boards to achieve the height required
- 4. Place the top composite U chanel insert on top of the last composite fence board and this should fit on top of the composite U chanel on each side
- 5. Using the Torx driver screw in the black screws on top of the composite U chanel into the top composite fence borad If you wish to secure the top board, you can use an adhesive silicon in the top composite U chanel insert and alco the composite U chanel insert that fits into the concrete posts
- 6. Please note that you may need to trim the composite fence boards if your concrete posts are not vertical and out of square
