Upon successful completion of the Metro Fire Officer Academy II, students will have met, or exceeded, all requirements of NFPA Fire Officer II.

## Attendance Requirements

- Students must make the commitment to attend all days in their course in order to receive a certificate of completion. *Zoom will be provided on a case-by-case basis although it is encouraged that all students plan on attending the lectures in-person (this is for their benefit in learning and making connections with the instructors and their peers)*

## Course Work

- Didactic Learning for the courses will be from IFSTA Fire Officer I & II Online, through the IFSTA ResourceOne platform
- ACCESS KEYS will be emailed to the students within a few days from their registration into the courses.
- IFSTA Fire Officer I & II manuals are, additionally, provided to the students as part of the cost of the courses

The Company Officer, Organizational Structure, Leadership & Supervision, Human Resources Management, Communication, Administrative Functions, Occupational Safety, Health, & Wellness, Company-level Training, Building Construction, Fire Protection Systems, & Fire Behavior, Company-level Fire Inspections & Pre-incident Planning, and Delivery of Emergency Services

## Fire Officer II – Class Topics

The Company Officer II, Human Resources Management & Administrative, Responsibilities II, Origin & Cause Determination, Delivery of Emergency Services II, and Safety Investigations & Analyses
