- 7. Attend an interview if requested.

How the recipients are chosen:

- 1. Recipients are selected based on their academic or vocational excellence, school and community involvement, letters of recommendation, an essay, and financial need.
- 2. The Harry S. Foster, American Legion Post 67 Inc., Scholarship Committee will select the recipients.

Amount of Scholarship:

Harry S. Foster, American Legion Post 67 Inc., will award scholarships up to one thousand (\$1,000) dollars. Post 67 can change the amount and the number of scholarships to be awarded, contingent upon available funding.
