No Wake and Mooring Buoys

- Keep the no wake buoys on your left, and the mooring buoys on your right



Path Finder Kayaks

- We will have a pair of kayaks lead the event staying just ahead of the lead swimmer.
- These will help to identify where the swimmer should go, so the lead kayaker can focus on their tasks.
- Keep following the kayakers in front of you.
- If you realize that you are outside the No Wake Buoys, come back to the course as quickly as realistic on an angle.

Kayak assistance

- To help navigate, always steer your swimmer away from objects. You can hug the buoys so that they don't hit them. Also be on the lookout for mooring buoys, boats, play toys, rafts, and yes, dead fish.
- Make certain that you have the feeding and hydration plan down before you start.
- If you are on the lake side of your swimmer, be sure to move toward the lake if a large wake is coming in. These waves will lift the kayaker right onto the swimmer if you are not careful.
- Swimmers may touch the kayak, but you may not advance them by paddling.

Fishing Boats

- Fishing boats may appear in your path. They have a right to fish. Attempt to pass while staying in the course. There will be more kayakers, so they will likely move. Be polite at all times



Areas without buoys

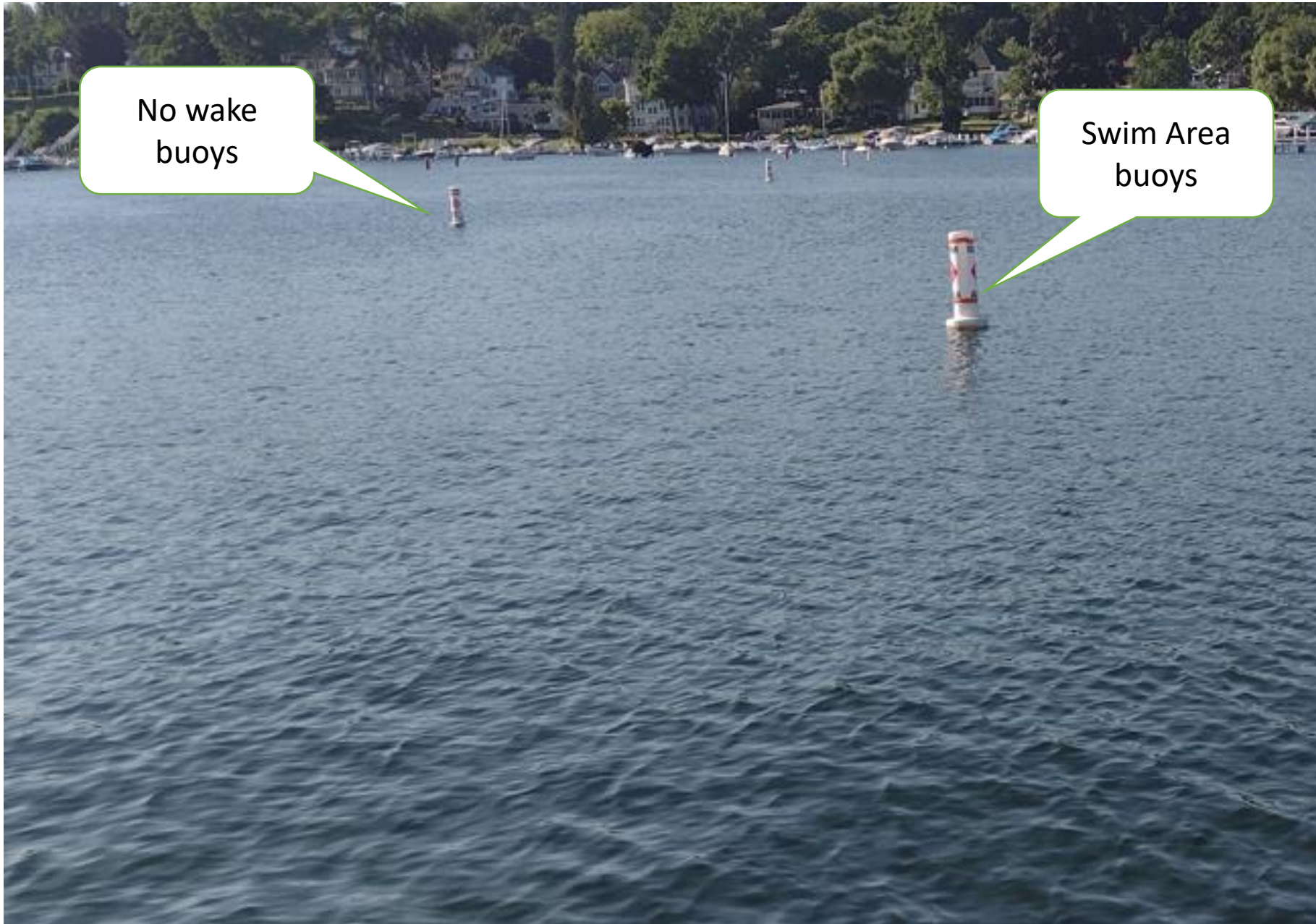
- Some parts of the lake are sparse on No Wake Buoys. In this instance, you can navigate inside the mooring buoys, but outside the boats.



Start of the Race

- North side of Fontana Beach.
- Swimmers will start in the water.
- We will start from the end of the pier heading South between the “No Wake” and “Swim Area” buoys.

Channel markers

- Go between the Red and Green channel markers.
- Kayakers should wait on the lake side, and pick up their swimmer by the channel markers.



Mile 2, 1st Relay Exchange

- Mile #2 is near dock 530.



Mile 3



Black Point

- You may go close to Black Point.
- Stay about 20 feet or more from shore to avoid weeds.
- This is at about 3.5 miles



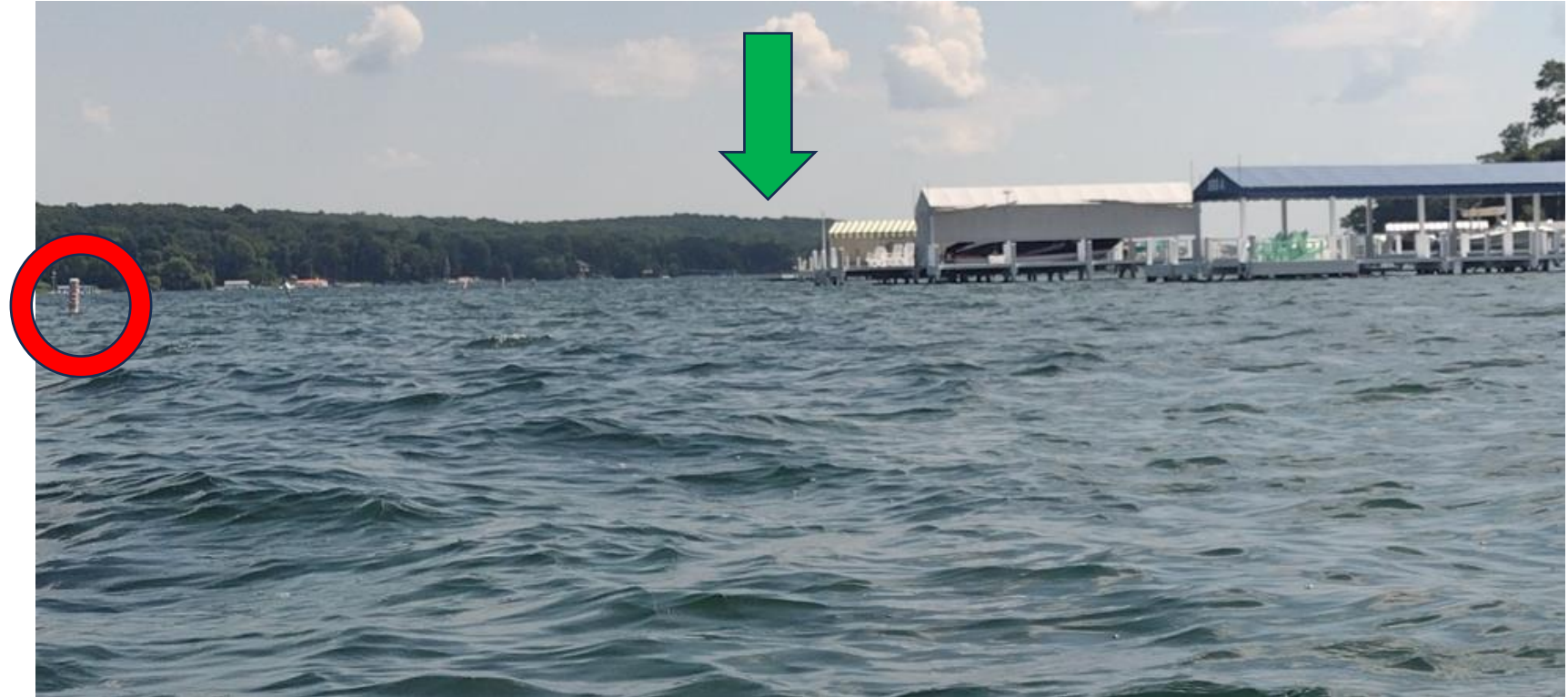
Mile #4

- The second relay exchange will be near dock 610, The Lake Geneva Highlands docks.



Dock 667

- After Dock 667, hug the docks. The buoys are out of your way



Mile #5

- Mile #5 is near dock 677
- The Linn Boat Launch is just ahead



LGCC – Mile #6

- The final relay exchange will take place right in front of the dinning room of the Lake Geneva Country Club.



Weeds near dock 715

- Hug the outside buoys after the country club. This area gets shallow until you are near the swimming area.



Mile #7 is dock 774E



Dock 795

- The last buoy is near dock 795. At this point, you can head to the northern boats in the marina



Race Finish

- As you round the moored boats, you will see an arch anchored in the water just off of the South end of the beach. Your time ends when you touch the arch!
- Do not swim through the marina, stay on the outside of the boats.
