

RBOA BIG NEWS: MAY 2022

Our first issue is the addition to our board of two new members, Nicole Patten as Secretary/Treasurer and Joe Bradley as our Director for Environment. We still have an urgent need for a Board Vice President. We've had discussions with three RBOA members about the position which has only the duty to substitute for the President when he/she isn't available. Still, no one has accepted the opportunity. Please consider joining us so that our seven member board will have all positions filled, and we can continue to serve our neighbors.

Our second bit of news is probably of greater interest to more of our members:

The Rocky Bayou Owners Association and the Rocky Bayou Country Club signed a Letter of Agreement in April of 2022 which will be in effect for one year on a trial basis. Below are the terms of the agreement:

RBOA will buy one annual Gold Family (equivalent) Membership to the RBCC for a total cost of \$2808 plus tax. This membership will not be subject to initiation fees or any special assessments.

RBOA members who sign a release / waiver of liability may walk/fish on the RBCC golf course during non-golf playing hours as defined by RBCC. With the signed release the RBOA member household will agree to obey all the rules of the RBCC for using the golf course for walking/fishing.

RBCC will offer annual Social Memberships to RBOA members for \$40/month, plus tax.

RBOA will be authorized to reserve the RBCC Club House for up to four of its meetings during the year.

After one year, the respective boards of the RBCC and RBOA will decide if the agreement may be renewed or modified in the future.

This agreement is now in effect. Note that the discount given the RBOA members for a Social/swim pass is more than the cost of your RBOA dues on a per month basis. If the Country Club follows its tentative plan and builds pickleball courts, the Social membership will include their use as well. We hope this agreement gives you an attractive option for enjoying where you live.
