At last year's annual meeting and in an update as recently as a few months ago, I mentioned that speeding on Ruckel Drive is the most pressing safety issue facing our community. I wanted to take a moment and provide a further update.

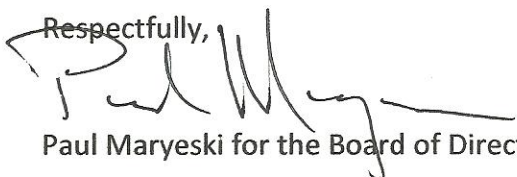
- Approximately 4 months ago new speed limits signs were placed on Ruckel Drive.
- Several times during the last 3 months a "Speed Trailer" with a digital reading of each car's actual speed has been placed on various spots on Ruckel.
- In December, the Sheriff's Department stepped up enforcement and started writing tickets for moving violations.
- Starting next week, an additional resource from the Sheriff's Office dedicated to traffic law enforcement will be made available to enforce the speed limit on Ruckel Drive.

For the safety of all residents the speed limit on Ruckel Drive, and all of our streets in Rocky Bayou, need to be respected. As residents of the area, we need to do our part including:

- Respecting the speed limit, and communicating to other family members who have not received this note that observing the speed limit is all important.
- Remind friends that the speed limit on Ruckel is patrolled and must be respected.
- Talk to your contractors and service providers (lawn maintenance, pool service, etc.) that the speed limits must be respected.
