

Thank you for your interest in our summer ABA program at Irving **THROU** Bible Church! We are excited to offer one of the first adult Applied Behavior Analysis program with 1:3 ratio's for your adult learner. This is a sample schedule for our T/TH program from 9am-3pm.

9:00-9:30: Check in, greet staff and friends, backpacks put away, bathroom time. Data tracking on completion and independence skills.

9:30-10:00: Calendar time, weather, events, work on individual goals with data tracking on communication. Morning snack/drink time (consist of crackers/fruit and water). Data tracking on requests/mands for activity.

10:00-10:30: Stretch time, walk around, gross motor skills, group play, communication for preferred activities. Data tracking on spontaneous communication and participation.0:

10:30-11:00- Pre-vocational/vocational training with work box completion. Also will be working on stocking/pulling groceries, delivering items to other rooms in the building, sorting clothes and organizing coffee bar area. Data collection on independence level and duration

11:00-11:30- Free time! Learners get to pick preferred activity of games and interactions. Data collection on communication and completion.

11:30-12:00- Bathroom break, hygiene time. Work on Individual Goals for each group. Data collection on completion and independence level, with breaks for reinforcement.

12:00-12:30- Lunch time. Data collection on completion and interactions.

12:30-1:00- Group time with Music or arts and crafts, walk around and gross motor skills. Data tracking on participation and communication.

1:00-1:30- Work in individual goals. Data tracking for completion

1:30-2:00- Bathroom break, hygiene time. Preferred activity for learner. Data tracking for independence level and communication.

2:00-2:30- Pre-vocational and vocational skills. Work on independence skills to completion with data tracking on duration of work and preferred vocation.

2:30-3:00- Get ready to go home. Get items together, work on communication skills and transitioning. Data collection on completion and communication.



Due to the highly trained staff and the cost of quality of THROUGH the care provided by TTC, the financial commitment to attend each day is set at \$145. We are currently INN network with BCBS. Please contact us to learn more. An autism diagnosis is needed for ABA services to be approved through insurance.

Expectations:

- Tuition is paid at the beginning of every month. September tuition will be due on Aug. 30th in the amount of \$1160. All payments will be sent to families via Quickbooks invoice.
- Late payment of \$25 starts after the 1st and there will be a second late payment fee of \$25 if not received by the 5th of the month.
- There will be a one time materials fee of \$125 for each learner but this is a one time fee that is due on Aug. 30th.
- Families are expected to complete an AFLS assessment and provide all previous assessments to determine acceptance into the program.
- Learners are expected to have enough independent skills to work in a 3:1 ratio environment.

Again, excited you have chosen to participate in our first summer program! Our commitment to you and your learner is to provide the best quality of care possible to help further independence, self-help, vocational, social and communication skills. Data tracking sheets will be sent home each day so parents/caregivers know about their day.
