Dear Art lovers,

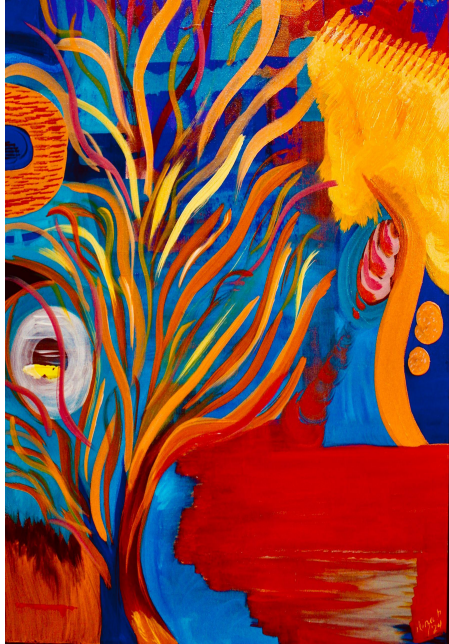
