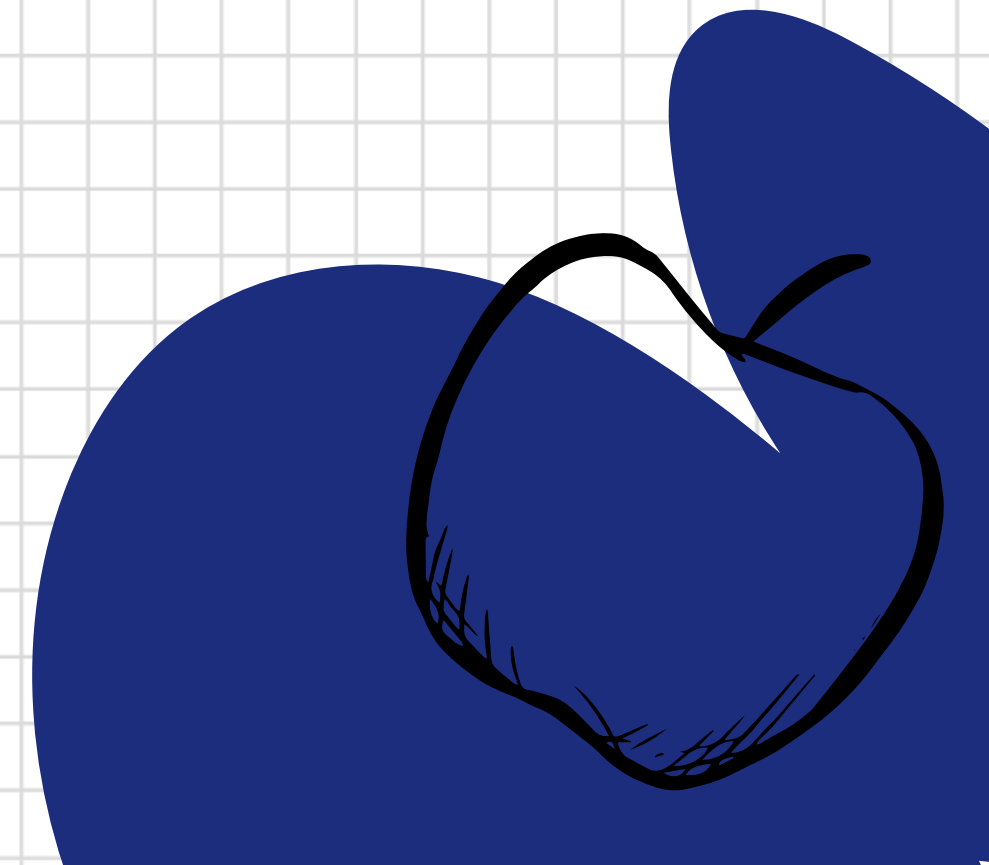



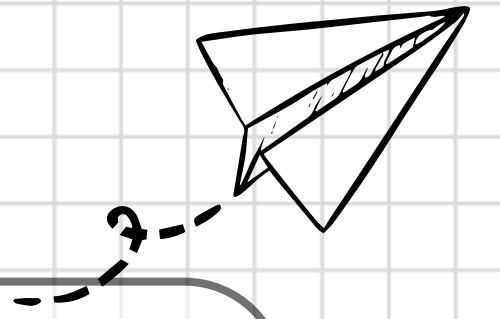

# IMPACT REPORT

## WHERE THE MONEY GOES

### STAFF SUPPORT & APPRECIATION



- 11 grants totaling \$1,581.01 for classroom materials to kickstart the year
- 7 grants totaling \$870.17 for Project-Based Learning supplies for hands-on learning
- 37 grants totaling \$10,545.32 from the Fun Run Grant to support classroom resources
- 23 grants at about \$4,369.76 for resources needed that cover a short-term need like flood support and resource teacher tools like speech games
- 2 full-time aides and their benefits at \$88,206
- Teacher Of The Month recognition program
- 6 flood grants to support the displaced teachers and the necessary materials for their mobile or temporary classrooms
- Staff wellness and support packages
- Lunches for staff during conferences, teacher appreciation week, school kick off, before school lunch during their in-service meetings and thankful lunch
- Stocking the teachers' lounge with coffee, creamer and tea all year.
- Supply Closet support for classrooms with pencils and Clorox wipes.
- The custodial staff and bus driver appreciation
- Art fund for additional supplies
- Library fund for new books
