2025-26 4th Grade Spirit Shirt Design Contest

Every year, the PTO sponsors a contest for fourth grade students to design the year's spirit shirts to be worn on Fridays in lieu of uniform tops.

Please ensure that all contest entries fully comply with all requirements set forth below as failure to follow the rules will result in disqualification no matter how creative the design.

This year we invite all fourth graders to submit original artwork with the theme:

¡Ser bilingüe es mi Superpoder!

AND

Being Bilingual is my Superpower!

The design **must include**: (1) the theme in both English and Spanish, (2) at least two benefits of being bilingual, and (3) at least one visual element associated with Madison Heights, such as a mountain, Eddie the Eagle, or the Keys to Success (Respectful, Responsible, and Safe). In the design, students need to include a couple of benefits of being bilingual.

This is your opportunity to creatively express how much Madison Heights means to you. All artwork must be drawn on a WHITE 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper, use BLACK ink - <u>NO COLOR</u>. All drawings must be original - which means no tracing or adult assistance! The drawings must not contain spelling errors.

Drawings need to be completed and <u>turned in by Monday, August 18, 2025.</u> Write your <u>name on your artwork</u> and submit your drawing to your classroom teacher, who will deliver submissions to the PTO mailbox.

Several of the entries will be selected as finalists, and then every student in the school will vote for their favorite design. The design with the most votes will be made into this year's spirit shirt!
