

Refraction Fee Consent:

A Refraction is the process of determining your best corrected vision and if there is a need for corrective lenses. It is an essential part of the eye exam, and it is necessary to write a prescription for glasses or contacts. Refractions are not a covered service by Medicare or most medical insurance plans, they consider a refraction a vision service, not a medical service.

We do accept vision plans such as VSP and EyeMed. If you have one of these vision plans and want to use it, please notify us when making the appointment or prior to seeing the Ophthalmologist; we have an Optometrist who we can schedule you to see for your routine vision exam.

If you are seen by one of the Ophthalmologists and have not informed us of these plans until after the appointment, you will still be responsible for the refraction fee as we cannot bill medical and a vision plan for the same visit.

Canyon Eye Associates' fee for a refraction is \$60.00, this is in addition to any copayment, deductible, or coinsurance that is set forth by your insurance plan. This fee is collected at the time of service. Should your insurance plan cover the refraction, we will reimburse you accordingly.

I have read the above information and understand that the refraction is a non-covered service. I accept full financial responsibility for the cost of this service. I understand that any co-payment, coinsurance or deductible I may have are separate from and not included in the refraction fee.
