We will also consider graduating seniors who reflect Kiwanis values of exceptional service, leadership, and character in their application materials.

There is also a scholarship available for participants/graduates of our S.E.E.D. Program, offered in partnership with BSO.

The Scholarship Committee may choose to award additional scholarships at their discretion and based on available funding. **Applicants are only eligible to receive one scholarship from the Kiwanis Club of Deerfield Beach.**

Videos must be submitted in MP4 format or uploaded to YouTube/Vimeo with the link provided in the email you send.
2. A **recommendation letter** from a teacher, advisor, coach, religious leader, counselor, or supervisor. *PDF format preferred.*
3. A detailed **list of community service hours** including a description of what service you performed, where, and for whom; and, this list must be verified by an official representative of your school. *This list should be no longer than 3 pages; do not send individual service hour sheets.*
4. The **acceptance letter** to your school of choice.
5. Optional, but helpful: A **resume** and/or high school **transcript**.

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
