The Mother Lode Gun Club Board of Directors agreed to resume shooting venues, after Tuolumne County Dept of Health approved opening up the County to a higher level, following COVID-19 program.

We have a list of protocols (3 pages), which closely follow protocols initiated by the Cowboy clubs shooting the Sacramento Shooting Facility.

Please read these protocols (which are attached) and be familiar with them when you arrive at the shooting range on July 5th.

Everyone, shooter or observer, must turn in a signed/dated protocol before we commence shooting.

The protocols are a "work-in-progress". If some aspect does not work, then we will make appropriate adjustments.

Please.....

1. If you are not feeling well, stay home.
2. If you feel that you are at a greater risk level or not comfortable shooting under these conditions, stay home.
3. Adhere to the social distancing guidelines.

The high power shooters are having a 2-day event (July 4th and 5th) on the 100 yd range; so we are restricted to shooting on the 25 range. We will utilize the covered area behind the 50 yd range firing line to stage gun carts, if it is needed; dependent on how many cowboy shooters attend.
