A RSO will be assigned to the indoor range for general membership usage. A schedule will be announced during a general meeting prior to the following month a RSO will be present for usage.

- Review and sign indoor range rules and regulations
- Ensure lights and ventilation is in proper working order
- Report any damage or violations of the indoor range to the chief RSO
- Know the location of the first aid kit and the emergency phone
- Indoor range door will remain closed during live fire
- No food allowed in range
- Remove all your trash
- ONLY 22 SHORTS 22 LONGS OR 22 LONG RIFLE, COPPER LEAD FREE AMMUNITION
- Pick up all expended brass
- When leaving turn off lights and air ventilation system
- Ensure the indoor range is locked when exiting
