## MOTHER LODE GUN RANGE RULES AND SAFETY GUIDELINES RANGE OPERATION 100 YARD LINE

## **SHOOTING HOURS 8:00 TO SUNSET**

## SHOOTING RULES:

- 1. DURING AN OPEN SHOOT CHOOSE ONE SHOOTER TO ACT AS A RANGE SAFETY OFFICER (RSO). IF A CLUB CERTIFIED RSO IS AVAILABLE, HE OR SHE WILL TAKE CHARGE.
- 2. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL SHOOTERS, RECOMMENDED FOR SPECTATORS ON THE RANGE.
- 3. ALL SHOOTING IS TO BE DONE BEHIND THE **RED FIRING** LINE.
- 4. ARMOR PIERCING, INCENDIARY AND 50BGM AMMO PROHIBITED.
- 5. USE ONLY TARGET HOLDERS PROVIDED BY THE MLGC RANGE.
- 6. TARGETS FRAMES ARE POSITIONED AT THE 100 AND 200 YARD LINE. TARGETS MAY NOT BE PLACED CLOSER THEN 100 YARD TARGET FRAMES.
- 7. PAPER TARGETS ONLY.
- 8. DO NOT SHOOT AT OBJECTS ON THE GROUND, POSTS, OR CABLES
- 9. WHEN GOING DOWN RANGE DURING A CEASE FIRE, PLACE FIREARM ON THE BENCH OR IN THE RACK, UNLOADED WITH ACTION OPEN. IF USING A HOLSTER, RE-HOLSTER OR PLACE HANDGUN ON THE BENCH ACTION OR CYLINDER OPEN. CONFIRM LINE IS CLEAR TO MOVE FORWARD.
- 10. DO NOT SIT ON SITTING BENCHES.
- 11. PICK UP YOUR TRASH AND BRASS. LEAVE THE RANGE CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND IT.
- 12. NO ALCOHOL, MARIJUANA OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ALLOWED.
- 13. NO CROSS SHOOTING AT TARGETS.
- 14. ACTIVATE THE RED WARNING LIGHT TO ALERT SHOOTERS ON THE 25 AND 50 YARD LINE WHEN YOU ARE GOING DOWN RANGE BEYOND THE 100 YARD TARGETS. COORDINATE WITH SHOOTERS ON THE 25 AND 50 YARD LINE AND VISUALLY CONFIRM THAT A CEASE FIRE EXISTS BEFORE PROCEEDING DOWN RANGE. TURN OFF WARRING LIGHT UPON RETURNING TO THE FIRING LINE. WHEN TRAP SHOOTING IS IN PROGRESS, **DO NOT** WALK BEYOND THE 100 YARD TARGETS, AND STAY ON THE GRAVEL NEXT TO THE BERM.
