RANGE RULES AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

RANGE OPERATION 50 YARD LINE

SHOOTING HOURS 8:00 TO SUNSET

SHOOTING RULES:

1. DURING AN OPEN SHOOT CHOOSE ONE SHOOTER TO ACT AS A RANGE SAFETY OFFICER (RSO). IF A CLUB CERTIFIED RSO IS AVAILABLE, HE OR SHE WILL TAKE CHARGE.
2. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL SHOOTERS, AND HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR SPECTATORS ON THE RANGE.
3. ALL SHOOTING IS TO BE DONE BEHIND THE **RED FIRING LINE**.
4. CENTER FIRE RIFLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE 50 YARD LINE.
5. USE ONLY TARGET HOLDERS PROVIDED BY THE MLGC RANGE.
6. CABLES ARE POSITIONED AT THE 25 AND 50 YARD LINES.
7. PAPER TARGETS ONLY.
8. DO NOT SHOOT AT OBJECTS ON THE GROUND, POSTS, OR CABLES
9. WHEN GOING DOWN RANGE DURING A CEASE FIRE, PLACE FIREARM ON THE BENCH OR IN THE RACK, UNLOADED WITH ACTION OPEN. IF USING A HOLSTER, RE-HOLSTER OR PLACE HANDGUN ON THE BENCH ACTION OR CYLINDER OPEN. CONFIRM LINE IS CLEAR TO MOVE FORWARD.
10. DO NOT SIT ON SIGHTING BENCHES.
11. PICK UP YOUR TRASH AND BRASS. LEAVE THE RANGE CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND IT.
12. NO ALCOHOL, MARIJUANA OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ALLOWED.
13. NO CROSS SHOOTING AT TARGETS.
14. WHEN RED WARNING LIGHT AND HORN IS ACTIVATED, SHOOTERS ON THE 100 YARD LINE RANGE ARE GOING DOWN RANGE BEYOND THE 100 YARD LINE TARGETS. THE 25 AND 50 YARD LINE RANGE WILL IMMEDIATELY **CEASE FIRE**. PHYSICALLY CHECK THE 25/50 YARD LINE TO MAKE SURE THE SHOOTERS ARE NOTIFIED. A SAFE RANGE WILL EXIST WHEN THE RED LIGHTS ARE TURNED OFF BY THE SHOOTERS ON THE 100 YARD LINE.
