Everyone entering grandstands must pay gate fee of \$10.00

Everyone Entering Pit must pay \$15.00.

\$20.00 pit parking for non-participating vehicles

1980 through 2002 stock automobiles. NO hearses. Engine, transmission, and rear end must match make of car. Ex:) Ford to Ford, GM to GM

Cars must be 100% stripped on the outside, but you can leave front windshield.

Gas tank and battery must be relocated. It can only be left under the car if in front of rear suspension area.

You may have a driver and passenger door bar 12" past door post and 1 bar behind seat and a rollover bar. It must go straight up and down.

Any wheel and tire combo is allowed. But you can't reinforce any suspension components.

Tie rods, struts, trailing arms must be factory

Any OEM factory bumper cannot be seam welded or stuffed. In place of this, you can have a piece of metal, min. 2x2 max 4x4 ¼' as a bumper. Ends can't be capped. Tubing must be straight and not altered in any way.

No plates and factory bumper shocks only. You can have 1" weld from your bumper to frame and a 3x3 ¼ plate half on the bumper, half on the frame, to help hold bumper on.

Chain, tape, or wire your doors, hoods, and trunks. No welding at all.

No creasing quarters or frame rails. Can V your trunk in the center, but can't build a trunk.

Can raise front suspension and put a bolt for height. But absolutely no welding or reinforcing.

If you run a gas tank protector, it must be 6" away from all sheet metal, packaged tray, etc.

Front end can't be shortened or snub-nosed.

Headers are optional

You can spot weld a door skin on driver's door for safety.
