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Greetings,

It is once again time to make plans to attend the Western Kentucky State Fair 4-H and FFA Livestock shows! As a participant of our fair in the past, we wanted to make you aware of a few show dates and changes for this year. I have enclosed a rule book and show class list for your reference.

For the 2021 fair, we have restructured our livestock shows, due to other events in our county. Please take note of the following show times and dates:

Rabbits- **Monday, June 28**, check in 4-5:00 p.m., show at 6 p.m.

Poultry – **Tuesday, June 29**, check in 4-5:00 p.m., show at 6 p.m.

Sheep Show - **Wednesday, June 30**, check in 4:00-5:00 p.m., show at 6 p.m.

Dairy Goat Show- **Thursday, July 1**, check in 7:00-8:15 a.m., show at 9 a.m.

Goat Show- **Thursday, July 1**, check in 4:00-5:00 p.m., show at 6 p.m.

Swine Show- **Friday, July 2**, check in 7:00-8:15 a.m., show at 9 a.m.

Cattle Show- **Saturday, July 2**, check in 3:00-5:00 p.m., show at 6 p.m.

This year, to cut down on registration time, we are utilizing an online fair registration website, www.fairentry.com. **All participants must pre-register via this site for all livestock shows.** Simply go to the website and search for Western Kentucky State Fair. Once you find the fair, create an account. If you have created one in the past, it should still let you log in. If you cannot find the password, I can reset it on my end. I have included an informational sheet on how to set up an account and register for the various shows. Once we have everyone in the system, we will utilize FairEntry to do class breaks on age, weight, and breed. Market animals will still be weighed in at the fair but will need to be pre-registered in the system. Should you have any questions, please let our office know. Please note, the system will ask you for a Social Security Number. You **DO NOT** need to enter one, unless you are a Christian County 4-H member and have non-livestock exhibits. Enter a fake number such as 123-45-6789 to process your registration.

Set up your account as early as possible. Once you have created one and submitted entries, we will have to approve it on our end before it will allow you to add more. We will check daily, to ensure speedy registrations. Parents, this system is designed so that if you have multiple youth registering, you will have the ability to create 1 account, with multiple exhibitors under your account.



Money will be dispersed at the end of each show, instead of during the show. Do not leave the show without picking up your winnings.

GENERAL RULES

All livestock entries are to be entered by **5:30 p.m.** the day of the show.
To be judged by no later than **6:30 p.m.** with the intent of the show starting at **6 pm** and be released after the show.

With the following exceptions:

Hogs: To be entered and weighed between 7:30 and 8:30a.m. the day of the show.
To be judged Friday, 9:00 am.

Dairy Goats: To be entered and weighed between 7:30 and 8:30a.m. the day of the show.
To be judged Thursday, 9:00 am.

LIVESTOCK HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

All livestock/animals offered for sale or exhibition at Kentucky County Fairs shall meet the following regulations according to KRS Chapter 257:

- a. 302 KAR 20:040 (Entry into Kentucky)
- b. 302 KAR 20:065 (Sale and exhibition of Kentucky origin livestock)

Any questions concerning these health regulations should be directed to your local veterinarian or the Kentucky State Veterinarian's office at 502-564-3956.



Exhibitor Group (Family) Entry


Important Reminders

- Your fair probably has dates when entry is accepted into the fair. Be sure to complete your entries (including the final “Submit” step) prior to the cut-off date.
- Register all entries for each exhibitor in the family before proceeding to the Payment section.
- Be sure to click the “Submit” button when you have completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.
- Check your email inbox for a confirmation email with a list of your entries and any related fees.
- You will receive a second email when your entries have been approved by your fair or show.
- This website is adaptive, and some directions might be different than the ones listed below if using a mobile device


1. You may access your Fair or Show from their direct link or go to <http://www.fairentry.com> and click “Find Your Fair,” located on the top right of the page.



2. Filter by your state, click Search, and then click on the correct fair. (Western Kentucky State Fairy should appear)



3. If you have a 4HOnline family account, select to “Sign in with 4HOnline” and enter your login information. **#3 Is not applicable to KY 4-H or FFA**
NOTE: If you forgot your password for your 4HOnline account, you will need to go to 4HOnline to get a new password. Then use the new password (not the temporary password) to log in to FairEntry.
4. If you do not have a 4HOnline account, but have registered for a Fair with FairEntry before, enter your login information.
5. If you do not have a 4HOnline account and have not registered with FairEntry before, select to Create a New Account. Follow the instructions to create your account.



<p>6. Click “Begin Registration”</p>	
<p>Exhibitor Information</p> <p>If your fair is configured to accept both individual and team entries, click on the appropriate choice for your entry. (Some fairs may only be configured for individual entries.)</p>	
<p>1. Enter the exhibitor information into the required fields. Some forms may require different information depending on the Fair or Show.</p>	
<p>2. <i>(If you entered/spelled something incorrectly on the previous screen, you have the option to Delete this Exhibitor on this screen.)</i> Enter the information on the Contact Info screen—the only required field is the top Home Phone Number. You can use the same email address that you used to create the account, or an alternate one unique to the exhibitor. If they wish to receive text messages, enter the cell phone number and carrier. That number can be the same as the Home Phone Number entered above, or different. Click Continue when you are finished entering data.</p>	




3. Enter the mailing address. All fields, except Address continued, are required. If the exhibitor has the same address as another exhibitor in the Exhibitor Group, simply click “Copy” to add the address to the current Exhibitor record. Click Continue when all information is entered correctly.


4. **If your fair or show requests a Social Security Number for 1099 purposes, that will be Step 4 on the progress bar. Social Security Numbers are fully encrypted and only the last 4 digits will be visible after the number has been saved. They are not required for NON Christian County 4-H members**

5. If your fair or show asks additional questions, those will be step 4 or 5 on the progress bar at the top. Answer any questions, and click Continue.

If your fair requires you to upload any files for the exhibitor, those will be step 5 or 6 on the progress bar. Upload requested files, and click Continue.



Review the exhibitor information. If any information is incorrect, click the green Edit button in the appropriate group to change it. When all information is correct, click Continue to Entries.



Creating Entries

Each exhibitor can have multiple entries. One entry must be made for each item, animal, class, etc. For example, if an exhibitor is bringing 2 photographs, two entries into the photography class must be created. If an exhibitor is showing one horse in 5 events, five class entries must be created. Once all entries have been created for the first exhibitor, you have the choice of creating another exhibitor in this exhibitor group (and entries) or proceeding to check-out (submitting the entries, whether or not fees are charged).



1. Click Add an Entry beside the correct exhibitor (if more than one has been created).

2. Click Select beside the first department you wish to enter. Any departments that are not available for entry will be noted as "Not Available" with a short explanation.
3. After you select a department, you will see a list of divisions to select from, and then a list of available classes. *Also notice that there are blue "Change" links in case you mistakenly select an incorrect department, division, or class.*
4. After you have selected the class, click the green Choose button.

Multiple Entry Process

5. If your fair or show has turned on the Multiple Entries option for this area, you will see a screen similar to the view at the right. If you do not see checkboxes next to each class, this area uses the single-entry process (see step 14).
6. Click Change to select the Club to which these entries will be associated.
7. If this is an Animal Entry, click Add Animal and enter the Animal's details.
8. If this is a pen or group entry, Add multiple animals and then select to Enter a pen of animals.
9. Select which animals will be part of this entry (NOTE: these animals will be available for this exhibitor to use in other entries, if needed).

Check the box next to each class this animal will enter.



10. If this is not an animal entry or if animals will be added at check-in, simply select the classes and number of entries in each class that you would like to create for this exhibitor. Click Continue

Review the entries. If you need to make any changes, click Cancel. If everything is correct, click Create Entries.

- 11. If you need to add another exhibitor, click on the Exhibitors button at the top left and repeat the steps to create a new exhibitor.
- 12. If all entries are complete, click Continue to Payment.
- 13. If you need to add more entries for an existing exhibitor, click Add an Entry. **(This setting doesn't always appear, and if it is not on your screen, click the green banner at the top that says "Entries," and it will take you to the same place.)**

Single Entry Process

14. If your screen does not resemble the picture on the right, your fair may have used the **Multiple Entry Process** in this area. Repeat steps 5-10.
15. If your screen does resemble this one, select the Class.
16. Click Continue.

17. Select a Club or Chapter for this entry. If this is an open class entry a Club or Chapter may not be required.
18. If this is not an animal class entry, follow the instructions on-screen to enter any additional information such as Entry Description, Custom Questions or Custom Files associated with that entry.

19. If this is an **animal class entry**, you may be required to specify which animal will be exhibited in this class; that may be optional; or you may NOT be able to specify the animal at entry time. If you are able to do that, you will see the option to "Add an animal".
20. You will have two choices. Select "Choose an Existing Animal Record" to import and select animals from 4HOnline or animals already entered in FairEntry. Choose "Enter a New Animal Record" to enter new animal information.
21. Fill in all of the fields with information about the animal you intend to exhibit. Click Create and Add Animal when finished. If the animal information was entered incorrectly, you have the option to either Remove From Entry (creating a new animal) or Edit Animal Details. When it's correct, click Continue.

22. Any questions or file uploads related to entry in this class will be next. Click

Continue after answering those questions or uploading documents.

23. When each class entry is complete, you have three choices for what to do next:
- If all class entries have been completed for one exhibitor, you can **Register another Exhibitor** in this exhibitor group.
 - If this exhibitor has more class entries to make, you can **Add another Entry for this Exhibitor**.

If all entries for all exhibitors in the exhibitor group have been completed, **Continue to Payment** to finalize and submit your entries.

24. Review your entries for completeness and accuracy. *Notice the Summary and Detail buttons at the top of the list on the right.* If there are errors, click on the green Entries section at the top of the page. Click Continue when all information is correct.

25. Once all entries have been entered for exhibitors in your family, submit the invoice for approval.

26. **Due to money handling procedures, we are unable to process electronic payments online or at the show. Your invoice through this system will say \$0.00. Dairy Goat exhibitors will have a \$5.00 per animal fee the day of show. Payable by Check or Cash.**

27. You will receive an email message when the entries have been submitted for approval. You will receive a second email when the entries have been approved.
