I hope this letter finds you well. I am reaching out to you on behalf of Women Working with Women Empowerment, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit committed to transforming the lives of women from marginalized and underserved communities. These women are often the silent pillars of their families and communities—raising children, leading households, pursuing careers—yet they face overwhelming barriers to opportunity, mental health care, and education. Through holistic programs we aspire to help women break generational cycles, unlock potential, and lead boldly in every area of life. When we invest in women, we uplift entire communities.

4WE is committed to empowering women through entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and holistic wellness. Here are a few key statistics that highlight the urgency of our work:

- Women make up more than 40 percent of the overall workforce and earn an estimated 82 cents for every dollar earned by men.¹
- Hispanic or Latina women earned an estimated 58 cents (a pay gap of 42 cents on the dollar).¹
- Black or African American women earned an estimated 63 cents (a pay gap of 37 cents on the dollar).¹
- Some studies have found higher rates of postpartum depression among some pregnant and postpartum women of color, but many mental health conditions are undiagnosed and untreated due to stigma and poor access to treatment.²
- Women remain underrepresented across the pipeline, a gender gap that persists regardless of race and ethnicity. Yet progress is surprisingly fragile, especially for women of color, who continue to be underrepresented at every level and who view gender and race as obstacles to their advancement.³
