Dear Sponsor

I hope this message finds you in great spirits. I'm reaching out on behalf of Women Working with Women Empowerment (4WE), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization passionately committed to uplifting women from marginalized and underserved communities. At 4WE, we believe in the power and potential of every woman. Through holistic resources that support mental, spiritual, and physical well-being, we empower women to rise as confident leaders, nurturing parents, skilled professionals, and thriving entrepreneurs.

Despite the critical roles these women play in their families and communities, many continue to face systemic challenges in areas such as economic opportunity, education, and mental health. At 4WE, we are determined to break down these barriers and create pathways to lasting change.

Here are a few key statistics that highlight the urgency of our work:

- Women Make Up More than 40 Percent of the Overall Workforce and Earn an Estimated 82 cents for Every Dollar Earned by Men.¹
- Hispanic or Latina women earned an estimated 58 cents (a pay gap of 42 cents on the dollar)¹
- Black or African American women earned an estimated 63 cents (a pay gap of 37 cents on the dollar)¹
- Some studies have found higher rates of postpartum depression among some pregnant and postpartum women of color, but many mental health conditions are undiagnosed and untreated due to stigma and poor access to treatment.²
- Women remain underrepresented across the pipeline, a gender gap that persists regardless of race and ethnicity. Yet progress is surprisingly fragile, especially for women of color, who continue to be underrepresented at every level and who view gender and race as obstacles to their advancement.³

In 2025, Women Working with Women Empowerment (4WE) offered hands-on workshops featuring nutrition, cooking, and mental-health discussions, led by 4WE members who are certified nutritionists and licensed therapists. These workshops were designed to support mothers recently reunited with their children after completing substance-use detoxification treatment, with the goal of empowering families and rebuilding strong, nurturing bonds between mothers and their children. 4WE also hosted financial-literacy classes and expanded its impact by launching a Teacher's-Assistance initiative to support and uplift women in education.
