- Direct Entry English Requirement:
 - TOEFL: 85
 - IELTS: 6
 - Duolingo: 120 - 130
- iTep Online Test (provided by Fairmont)
- SJC (K-8), HAC (K-8) and Prep (9 - 12):
 - TOEFL: 80 - 40
